# SSSR Angel

This pattern was originally made for the Christmas in July Special Event for the Online Beginners Tatting Class

This pattern have been slightly changed from the original published for the Special Event.

## You need

Two shuttles and a suitable thread.
You need to know how to make single shuttle split rings (SSSR) and self closing mock rings (SCMR). If you don't know how to do SSSR these can be substituted by splitrings (SR). If you don't know how to do SCMR, there is a version of the pattern using chains.

## Symbols

| R | Ring |

| SR | Split ring, the two halves are separated by / |
| SSSR | Single shuttle split ring |
| SCMR | Self closing mock rings |
| numbers | The number of double stitches (dst) <br> p |

| ---- | Long picot |
| Even longer picot |  |

## Pattern

Start by using only one shuttle.

## Skirt

The photo shows the skirt before the body is done.
R1: 4-4.
(SSSR: 4/4.)x2
(SSSR: 6/6.)x2
R2: 6-6.
SSSR: 6/6.
(SSSR: 4/4.)x2
*
leave a small space
(SSSR: 4/4.)x2
SSSR: 6/6+ join to R2

(SSSR: 6/6.)x2
(SSSR: 4/4.) x 3

## Body, SCMR version

Add extra shuttle. Secure the thread at the top of the last SSSR of the skirt.
SCMR: 2+(join to *)
$2+$ (join to R1)
3(R: 2--2--2--2--2--2--2--2--2----14.) right wing 3(R: 5-1-1-1--1-1-1-1-5.) head
3(R: 14----2--2--2--2--2--2--2--2.) left wing 3.

## Body, chain version

C: $2+$ join to *
C: 2+ join to R1
C: 3 .
R: 2--2--2--2--2--2--2--2--2--2--12. right wing C: 3 .
$\mathrm{R}: 5-1-1-1-1-1-1-5$. head
C: 3 .
R: 12----2--2--2--2--2--2--2--2--2. left wing
$\mathrm{C}: 3$. Join to the beginning of the first chain
